What is LEROCHOL?

LEROCHOL is a prescription injectable medicine used along with diet and exercise to reduce low-density lipoprotein cholesterol (LDL-C), or “bad cholesterol,” in adults with hypercholesterolemia (high cholesterol), including heterozygous familial hypercholesterolemia (HeFH). It is not known if LEROCHOL is safe and effective in children.

What to expect once your prescription has been received by HealthDyne Pharmacy

If you and your doctor decide LEROCHOL is right for you and have submitted your prescription to HealthDyne Pharmacy, here's what you can expect:

Within 1 day:



Receive confirmation of prescription submission

HealthDyne Pharmacy will text you to let you know they have your prescription and provide you with a link to register. Expect a text from 833-772-4142.

Within 48 hours:



Register on the HealthDyne Pharmacy portal and check out

Provide a valid email and accept the program privacy and term acknowledgements. Complete registration details and provide a secure payment method.

[Within 2 business days of valid prescription and payment:]



Prescription shipped to your home

If approved for fulfillment, shipping and tracking details for weekday delivery will be provided in your portal account.

If you prefer to submit through your insurance, your prescription must still be submitted through HealthDyne Pharmacy for fulfillment. Please note, some insurance companies may not cover at this time.

Before starting LEROCHOL, tell your healthcare provider, including your pharmacist, about all your medical conditions, including if you are pregnant or plan to become pregnant, are breastfeeding or plan to breastfeed, or if you take other medicines, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements.

Using LEROCHOL

Use LEROCHOL exactly as your healthcare provider tells you to use it. LEROCHOL is a subcutaneous injection (under the skin) self-administered one time every month. If your healthcare provider decides that you or a caregiver can give the injections, you should receive training on the proper injection technique. Do not stop using LEROCHOL without talking to your healthcare provider, as cholesterol levels may increase if treatment is stopped.

Tips for remembering your monthly dose

LEROCHOL is uniquely designed for people who want a medication that fits into their schedule. Even with the convenience of a once-monthly dose, we know everyone needs a reminder from time to time.

Try using these helpful tips to ensure you take LEROCHOL as prescribed.



Pick a certain day of the month to take LEROCHOL that works best for you, like the 1st of the month or 1st Sunday of the month, and stick to it.



Set an alarm or reminder on your phone and mark your calendar.



LEROCHOL can be stored without refrigeration for up to 3 months.* Consider keeping your medication out on a counter or another area where you are sure to see it during your regular routine.



Make the most of your monthly injection by pairing it with a reward or ritual, like a healthy snack or favorite activity.

What are the possible side effects of LEROCHOL?

The most common side effects of LEROCHOL include injection site reactions such as redness, itching, swelling, pain, bruising, or tenderness, runny or stuffy nose and sore throat (nasopharyngitis), diarrhea, nausea, and swelling of the arms, hands, legs, or feet (peripheral edema). These are not all the possible side effects of LEROCHOL.

Tell your healthcare provider if you have any side effect that bothers you or does not go away.

Call your doctor for medical advice about side effects.
